Does God have a perfect will for each Christian? Can you be absolutely sure you've found God's individual will for your life? Garry Friesen examines the traditional view of God's will, then sets forth a different view that more accurately reflects Biblical teaching.

This new edition of *Decision Making* takes up the practical issues of choosing a mate, picking a career, giving of one's resources, and areas of disagreement between Christians, to give readers a new approach to knowing the will of God. He also addresses many of the arguments that have surfaced since the original printing of this book over 24 years ago.
