PASTOR HOSLER RECOMMENDS *"10 Dumb Things Christians Believe"* by Larry Osborne. Larry is a pastor of a 7,000-member evangelical church in California. The reader will be surprised at the discernment tools he will obtain from this book. It speaks of myths and urban legends most evangelicals believe and have become an integral part of *"Christianity"* without ever knowing that the Bible never taught these things. Because we are created in the image of God, we can acquire great wisdom without even embracing the gospel of grace. This is why I would call this book *"9 Dumb Things...And One Dumb Thing the Author Believes."* I have many good books like this that have drastically changed my views about important matters while the authors believed in salvation by works. Larry Osborn defines faith as works and misses the gospel by a million miles, but his other chapters contain information that could change your life forever. Read this book like I read it: eat the meat and spit out the bones, and you will be glad you did.
