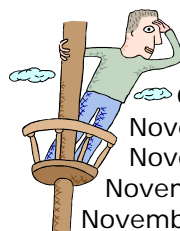
Choosing Gratitude by Nancy Leigh DeMoss

The Magnificent Obsession by Anne Graham Lotz

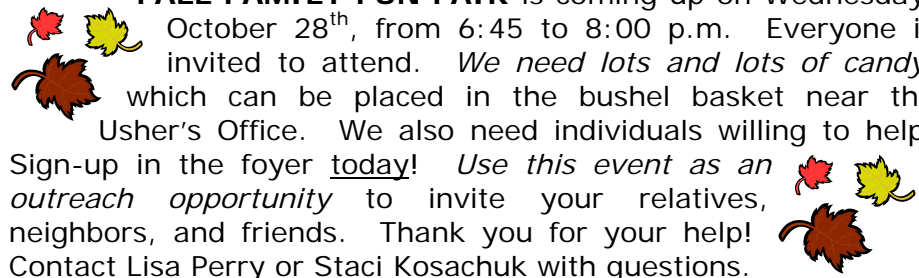
